

## **ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

### **Article I: Name**

The name of the corporation is A Cry for Help 2025.

### **Article II: Office**

### **Article V: Purpose**

In addition, these funds will be allocated to charitable, educational, and scientific purposes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Specifically, the corporation aims to provide aid and support to persecuted individuals and communities worldwide.

**Article VIII: Nonprofit Nature**

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article V hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

**Article IX: Dissolution**

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

**Article X: Amendments**

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by a majority vote of the board of directors.
